BOIL WATER RESCINDED/ NO LONGER REQUIRED

Effective: Saturday January 21, 2023

IT IS NO LONGER NECESSARY TO BOIL WATER PRIOR TO CONSUMPTION

On <u>Thursday January 19, 2023</u>, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the <u>Bolivar Peninsula Special Utility District</u>, <u>0840044</u>, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to a water line leak on Hwy 87 in Gilchrist, the water from Bolivar Peninsula SUD was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

Bolivar Peninsula SUD has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by Bolivar Peninsula SUD used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of <u>Saturday January</u> <u>21, 2023</u>.
