

BOIL WATER NOTIFICATION

BOLIVAR PENINSULA SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT
Public Water System I.D. No. 0840044

Effective: January 19, 2023

Due to a leak on our 20” water line on Hwy 87 in Gilchrist, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required Bolivar Peninsula Special Utility District to notify affected customers to boil their water prior to consumption. To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and ice making should be boiled and cooled prior to consumption. The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source. When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, water system officials will notify you.
